CURRICULUM

Our Infant/Toddler Community is designed to meet the individual needs of each child. We are more than just “baby sitting”. It is a highly developed program that is dedicated to assisting your child in discovering his/her world. Our instructors are extensively trained in Dr. Montessori’s proven methods.

Our environment is based upon a secure and loving environment. With the gradual introduction of stimuli and appropriate objects for sensorial experience and manipulation, the baby “absorbs” his/her environment. During the first three years the child creates the foundation for the person he/she will become. Our program helps the child understand his/her environment, including: people and their characteristics, things and their usual position and function, and attitudes whether positive or negative.

The furniture and classroom are developmentally appropriate and designed to meet the special needs of children of this age group. Our curriculum utilizes the specially developed Montessori perceptual materials to foster learning motivation and sensorial exploration. The curriculum maximizes the child’s exposure to language and encourages the development of coordination and social graces and courtesies. The children gain an appreciation for learning and develop appreciation of caring for themselves, their environment, and others. Each child’s pace and individual rights are respected in a spirit of harmony and cooperation.

MEALS AND SNACKS

Nutrition is very important to us at Montessori Academy of Upland. Montessori Academy of Upland offers a hot lunch program which is at an additional cost to the school’s tuition \$4.25 per day (subject to change). Parents can bring their child’s breakfast and lunch daily. Snack is scheduled on a rotating calendar where the student will be assigned one day each month to bring snack for the class. Parents will be notified of the items needed the week prior to the next month. If the child is not yet eating solid foods parents are asked to bring prepared bottles daily in the servings recommended for the child’s age with the child’s name and date on each bottle. As the children are maturing into solid foods, serving times and amounts will be discussed and arranged with the lead teacher. When the child is eating all solid foods, there will be discussion of the child’s readiness to be placed on the snack schedule.

We are a tuition-based program. The tuition is based on the calculations of the school days that we offer as listed on our calendar. There are 13 days of holiday day care offered this school year at an additional fee. You can select to enroll in a payment plan that is separate to your tuition cost. Your tuition is equally divided into monthly or weekly payments. All payments are equal regardless of the number of days the school is in session or the number of days the student attends. There are no reductions in tuition for absences due to illness, family vacations, or other reasons. If a child is enrolled after school starts, tuition is pro-rated.
