CURRICULUM

The Children's House, for children approximately three to six years of age, is designed to appropriately enrich, stimulate, and challenge the preschool and kindergarten aged child. It is prepared as carefully as the Infant – Toddler environment, to satisfy the child's need for constructive activity at a higher level.

Children at this age have what Dr. Montessori called the "Absorbent Mind". They can absorb all aspects of the environment and do it without effort or fatigue. The child will work diligently with focused concentration with the carefully prepared environment, cultivating a love of learning and gaining an ability to express themselves clearly.

The Children's House environment has five main areas: practical life, sensorial, language, math and cultural extensions. In addition, the program curriculum also includes training in music, art and social skills. The emphasis at this age is to guide the child to be independent in their most immediate worlds, their classrooms, and their homes.

MEALS AND SNACKS

Nutrition is very important to us at Montessori Academy of Upland. Montessori Academy of Upland offers a hot lunch program which is at an additional cost to the school's tuition \$4.25 per day (subject to change). Parents can bring their child's breakfast and lunch daily. When children are eating breakfast at school, parents are asked to provide 3 food groups and all packed lunches should consist of 4 food groups. Snack is scheduled on a rotating calendar where the student will be assigned one day each month to bring snack for the class. Parents will be notified of the items needed the week prior to the next month.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

We offer several after school activities which include soccer and dance, as well as others at times depending on the student interest. These classes are provided by qualified staff members or outside vendors. The classes are scheduled after school hours, usually 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., and are offered at an additional cost paid directly to the provider or instructor.

We are a tuition-based program. The tuition is based on the calculations of the school days that we offer as listed on our calendar. There are 13 days of holiday day care offered this school year at an additional fee. You can select to enroll in a payment plan that is separate to your tuition cost. Your tuition is equally divided into monthly or weekly payments. All payments are equal regardless of the number of days the school is in session or the number of days the student attends. There are no reductions in tuition for absences due to illness, family vacations, or other reasons. If a child is enrolled after school starts, tuition is pro-rated.

DISCOUNTS AND ADDITIONAL FEES

Annual Payment Plan

(4% tuition discount for each student)
 Full payment due by June 1st for Year Round or August 1st for Academic School Year

Semi-annual Payment Plan

(2% tuition discount for each student)
 Installment 1 (50% of annual tuition) is due by June 1, 2023 for Year Round and August 1, 2023 for Academic Year Only
 Installment 2 (50% of tuition) is due by January 4, 2024.

Monthly Payment Plan

Payments are due by the first of each month.
 Partial and late payments are subject to a \$25.00 late fee.

Weekly Payment Plan

Payments are due by Friday for the week following.
 Partial and late payments are subject to a \$25.00 late fee.

Sibling Discount

10% off 2nd child and any additional children.
 All discounts apply to the oldest children.
