CURRICULUM

Our Toddler Community is designed to foster the child's tremendous physical and cognitive growth that occurs during this stage of life. It is a highly developed program that is dedicated to assisting your child in discovering his/her world. Our instructors are extensively trained in Dr. Montessori's proven methods.

Our environment is based upon a secure and loving environment where the child can develop independence and a solid foundation for learning. The environment is carefully prepared with materials that will entice the child's curiosity and expand language development, gross motor skills, fine motor skills, and social and emotional development. During the first three years the child creates the foundation for the person he/she will become. Our program helps the child understand his/her environment, including: people and their characteristics, things and their usual position and function, and attitudes whether positive or negative.

The furniture and classroom are developmentally appropriate and designed to meet the special needs of children of this age group. Our curriculum utilizes the specially developed Montessori perceptual materials to foster learning motivation and sensorial exploration. The curriculum maximizes the child's exposure to language and encourages the development of coordination and social graces and courtesies. The children gain an appreciation for learning and develop appreciation of caring for themselves, their environment, and others. Each child's pace and individual rights are respected in a spirit of harmony and cooperation.

MEALS AND SNACKS

Nutrition is very important to us at Montessori Academy of Upland. Montessori Academy of Upland offers a hot lunch program which is optional at an additional cost of \$4.75 per day (subject to change). Parents can bring their child's breakfast and lunch daily. When children are eating breakfast at school, parents are asked to provide 3 food groups and all packed lunches should consist of 4 food groups. Snack is scheduled on a rotating calendar where the student will be assigned one day each month to bring snack for the class. Parents will be notified of the items needed the week prior to the next month.

We are a tuition-based program. The tuition is based on the calculations of the school days that we offer as listed on our calendar. There are 11 days of holiday day care offered this school year at an additional fee. You can select to enroll in a payment plan that is separate to your tuition cost. Your tuition is equally divided into monthly or weekly payments. All payments are equal regardless of the number of days the school is in session or the number of days the student attends. There are no reductions in tuition for absences due to illness, family vacations, or other reasons. If a child is enrolled after school starts, tuition is pro-rated.

DISCOUNTS AND ADDITIONAL FEES

Annual Payment Plan

(4% tuition discount for each student)

Full payment due by June 1st for Year Round or August 1st for Academic School Year

Semi-annual Payment Plan

(2% tuition discount for each student)

Installment 1 (50% of annual tuition) is due by June 1, 2024 for Year Round and August 1, 2024 for Academic Year Only
Installment 2 (50% of tuition) is due by January 1, 2025.

Monthly Payment Plan

Payments are due by the first of each month.

Partial and late payments are subject to a \$25.00 late fee.

Weekly Payment Plan

Payments are due by Friday for the week following.

Partial and late payments are subject to a \$25.00 late fee.

Sibling Discount

10% off 2nd child and any additional children.

All discounts apply to the oldest children.

Field Trip Fees
