

COVID-19 Decision Tree



SYMPTOMS:

Fever (low grade or over 100°F)
Headache
Congestion/Runny Nose
Sore Throat
Vomiting/Nausea, Diarrhea
Fatigue/Muscle or Body Aches

HIGH RISK SYMPTOMS:

New, Uncontrolled Cough
Difficulty Breathing (Not Asthma)
Loss of Taste or Smell

Any symptom **NO EXPOSURE** to
COVID-19 positive case

Follow MAU illness policy (may
return to school when
symptom(s) are gone or alternate
diagnosis is provided by doctor
and 24 hours fever-free without
medication.

Diagnosed with Covid-19

Regardless of Vaccination

- Stay home for at least 5 days.
 - Test on day 5.
 - End quarantine if no symptoms and negative test on or after day 5.

- Unable to test or choosing not to test**
 - symptoms are not present or are resolving, isolation can end after day 5
 - but masks should be worn through day 10.

ISOLATION GUIDELINES:

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status:

- Stay home for at least 5 days beginning the day after symptoms occurred or day following positive test if asymptomatic.
 - Test on day 5.
- If test results are negative **and** you have no symptoms (24-hour fever-free) or your symptoms are resolving after day 5, you can return to school.
- If test is negative but some symptoms are present, a doctor's note with alternate diagnosis is required to return to school.
